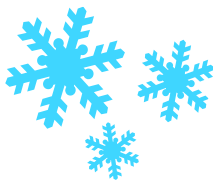

The meeting is open to the public & all are invited to attend. Meetings are usually held the third (3rd) Monday of each month.

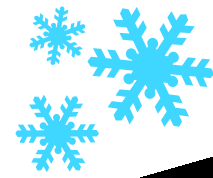
