Fiscal Year 2013 was a milestone year for the BJCF. As a result of gifts, contributions to special projects, and fundraising activities, the BJCF had receipts of \$407,775 this past year!

The 2013 results mainly reflect your generosity in making contributions to the BJCF Community Center Building Fund in the amount of \$372,914. Working together with the Town of Boulder Junction Fundraising Committee, the Foundation has collected donations far exceeding the original goal of \$250,000.

In addition, more than \$44,000 was added to the BJ Community Restricted Endowment Fund during 2013, increasing its total assets from \$19,908 as of December 31, 2012, to \$68,886 as of December 31, 2013.

The Foundation fulfills its purpose by distributing funds to Boulder Junction's nonprofit agencies, organizations, and educational institutions. In 2013, more than \$251,000 was returned to Boulder Junction in the form of grants and distributions. The beneficiaries included the new Boulder Junction Community Center and Library, the 8th Grade Class at North Lakeland School, the Community Food Pantry, the Boulder Junction Christmas Scholarship Fund, and the Campership Fund at Camp Manito-wish YMCA.

Current Funds

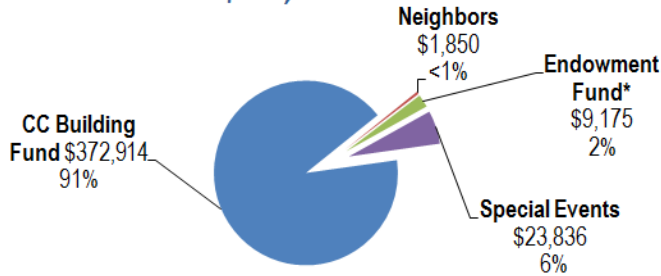
BOULDER JUNCTION COMMUNITY RESTRICTED ENDOWMENT FUND – The Endowment Fund is managed, invested and kept in perpetuity to provide earnings for the benefit of charitable causes in Boulder Junction. The Endowment Fund is currently held and managed by the Community Foundation of North Central Wisconsin.

BJCF NEIGHBORS FUND – Gifts to this fund, established in May, 2012, support the operations of the Foundation, ensuring the continuation of our work in Boulder Junction.

BJCF COMMUNITY CENTER BUILDING FUND – Gifts to this fund established in November, 2012, support the construction of the new Boulder Junction Community Center and Library and reduce the tax burden upon all taxpayers.

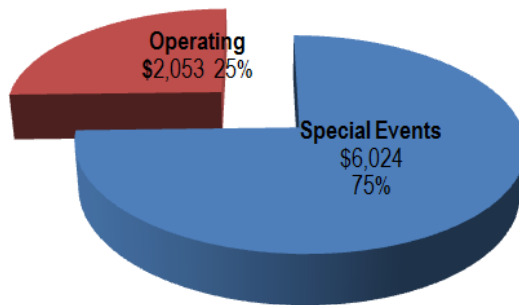

2013 Contributions & Event Receipts \$407,775

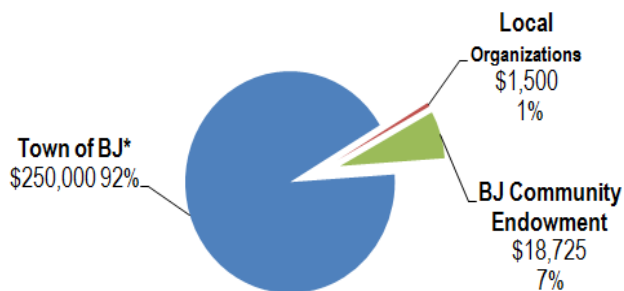

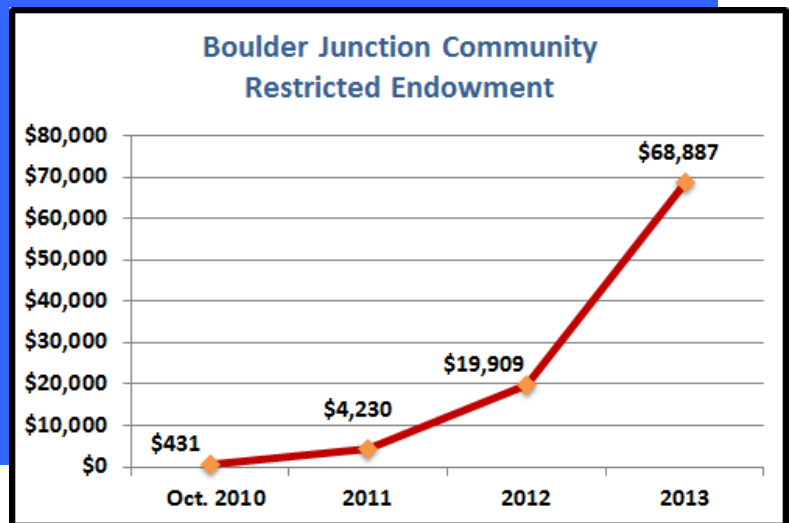

The Boulder Junction Community Restricted Endowment Fund was established for the purpose of creating a fund that will generate proceeds in perpetuity to benefit the Boulder Junction community. The Community Foundation of North Central Wisconsin manages the investment of the principal in the Endowment Fund and in time will distribute grants to applicants based upon the recommendation of the Board of Directors of the BJCF.

This year the BJCF contributed \$9,750 from the net proceeds of its special events to the BJ Community Restricted Endowment Fund.

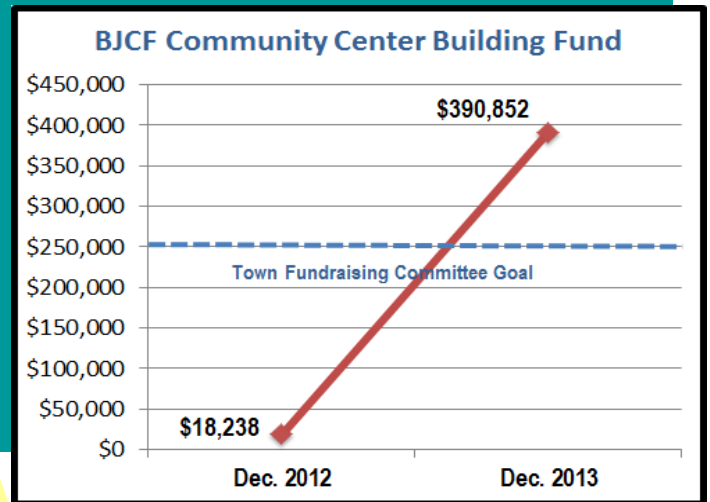

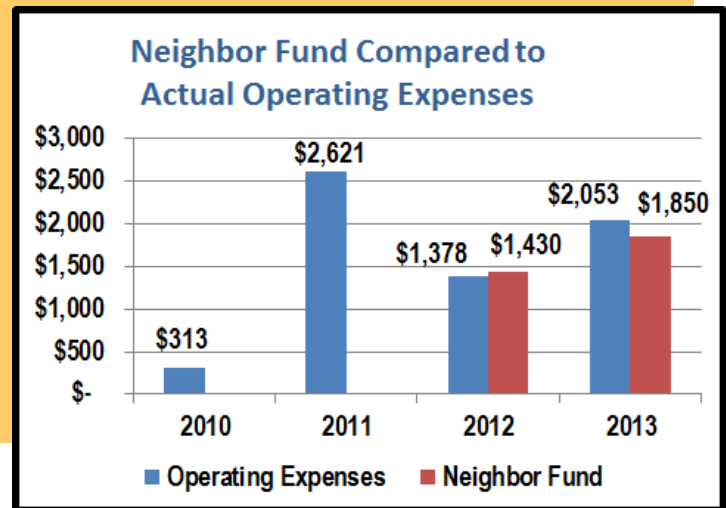
With Gratitude to the Many Donors.....

Special events allow the BJCF to raise funds that can be immediately turned back into the community as well as supplement fundraising for the BJ Community Restricted Endowment. During 2013, the BJCF raised over \$23,800 through special events with net proceeds exceeding \$17,100. The NLS 8th graders, Camp Manito-wish YMCA, the Christmas Scholarship Fund, and the Community Food Pantry were all recipients of Community Impact Distributions. In addition, the BJCF contributed \$9,750 from the net proceeds of its special events to the BJ Community Restricted Endowment Fund.
