*Greatest Needs Fund*

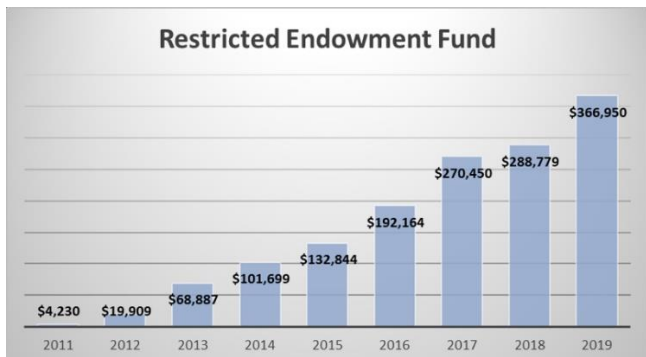
